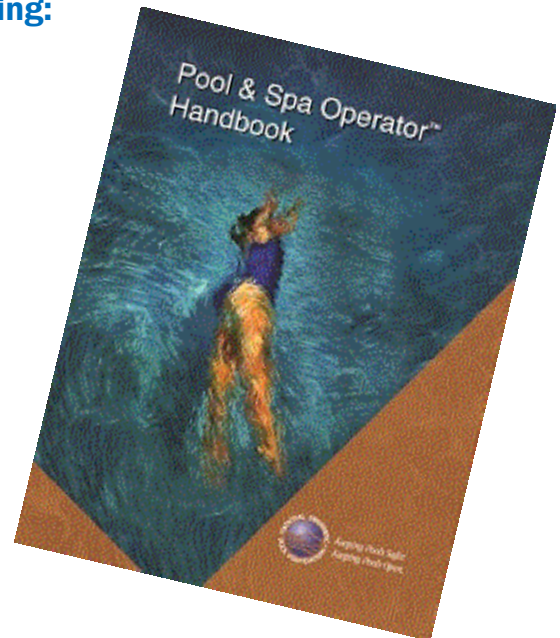

Roy holds a Ph.D. in bacterial physiology, masters and bachelor's in microbiology. He has over 80 scholarly papers and presentations on the selection and use of industrial biocides, biocide testing methodology, the microbiological of swimming pools and spas, and the governmental regulation of biocides.

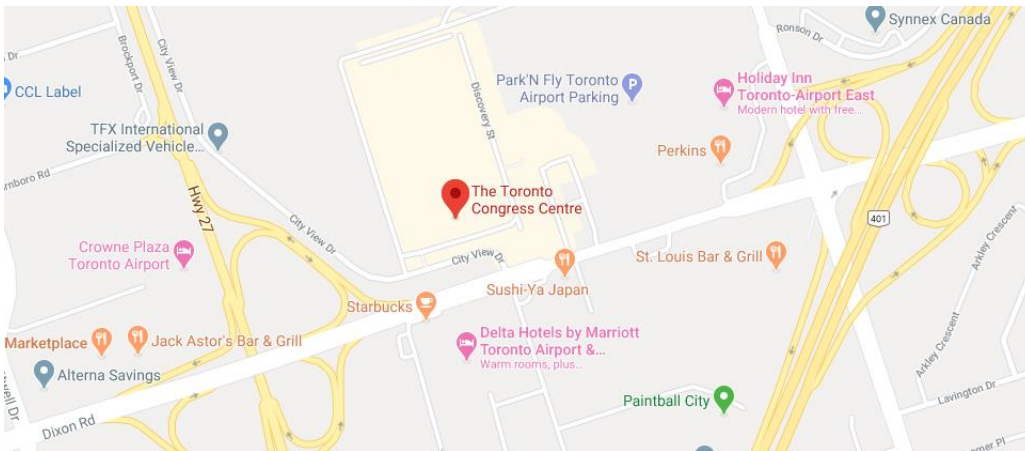
